<b>+ies</b> (words that end in <i>consonant _y</i> )	<i>city</i>	<i>cities</i>
<b>+ves</b> (words that end in <i>_for _fe</i> )	<i>wolf</i>	<i>wolves</i>
<b>exceptions</b>	<i>man</i>	<i>men</i>

### Rules for the Past Tense (Regular Verbs)

**Rule 1:** for most words, add *ed* (wash-washed; cook-cooked)

**Rule 2:** for words that end in *e*, add *d* (like-liked; close-closed)

**Rule 3:** for words that end in consonant-*y*, drop *y* and add *ied* (try-tried; hurry-hurried)

**Rule 4:** for 1-syllable words that end in consonant-vowel-consonant (except *w,x,y*), double the last letter and add *ed* (hop-hopped; fan-fanned)
